Property Improvement

Our Property Improvement Committee (PIC) form has been updated to include our new management company information. If you are planning to make any improvements to the front of your home, adding any fencing, or doing any major changes to your backyard, please consult the rules and regulations to see if you need to submit a PIC form. Hot tubs and air conditioners require HOA approval before being installed. If you are painting your house the same color that it already is, you do not need HOA approval. If you want to change the existing color, you need to get HOA approval first. Summer will be here before we know it, so you might want to consider getting your house painted this year if it is needed!

Yard Maintenance

Please keep your yards maintained year round. Any dead foliage should be removed on a regular basis. A friendly reminder that vegetable gardens are not allowed in front yards and should not be seen from the street (per the rules and regulations). If your yard does not have grass, you should have plantings four foot on center (per the rules and regulations), not just bark.
